We are committed to providing transparent prices and helping people to arrange a funeral that they can afford. This price list includes the CMA required price list and pages containing prices for our bespoke products and services that we typically provide to our families. We hope this helps you to make an informed decision about the type of funeral service you may wish to arrange.

Standardised Price List

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only)	£1,955
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£895
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care	£295
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at the funeral director's branch premises.	£195
Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from oak effect enviro-board	£270
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer)	£5
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle	£295

UNATTENDED FUNERAL	
This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.	
Burial (funeral director's charges only)	£995
Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee)²	£1,495

Disbursements

These are fees paid to us, to pay third parties on your behalf. They typically include crematorium, burial or newspaper notice fees. To help you understand what a funeral may cost, we have highlighted fees below, as a guide to local charges in our area.

Our funeral colleagues will provide you with the actual charges applicable to the funeral arrangements during the consultation and we will provide you with a written estimate. Please note that these prices are out of our control and are subject to change without prior notification. Cemetery fees can vary considerably dependent upon location, grave type and depth, residency and ownership.

OUR TERMS OF BUSINESS

By appointing Lincolnshire Co-op Funeral Services as your funeral director, you agree to our Terms of Business which include the following:

- Payment of a deposit which is not less than the total of the third-party costs associated with the funeral, otherwise known as the disbursements. Lincolnshire Co-op may search the files of a credit reference agency which will keep a record of their enquiry. Please note that if the search returns a failed credit check, this will result in demand for full payment of the total funeral price in advance of the funeral.
- Payment of the deposit as referred to above, must be made within 48 hours of the funeral arrangement interview during which you signed our arrangement form. If the deposit payment is not made within the time stated, the funeral may be postponed and not rearranged until such payment has been made. An invoice will be sent to you soon after the funeral has taken place. The balance is payable within 30 days of receipt of the invoice.
- We do not offer payment terms for balance payments.
- In the event of late payment of our invoice, we reserve the right to apply interest at 2% above the bank base rate per annum from the date of the invoice until payment is received. If the invoice remains unpaid, we may transfer your debt to another company for collection.
