Customers who spend £5 instore will also be able to claim a free drink of their choice when they show a digital voucher, which is available at lincolnshire.coop/freedrink

Drinks available through this offer, which is available until 6th September, include Costa Express, Tango Ice Blast, Slushy Jack's, Frozen Coca-Cola and Frozen Fanta.
